ROUTE DE LODEWIJK NAPOLEON

A cycling route with a royal touch! With the 'Route de Lodewijk Napoléon', you literally follow in the footsteps of the First King of Holland: Lodewijk Napoléon. Lodewijk De Goede, as his nickname was, took the initiative in 1809 to pave the dirt road Amers-foot, via Terschuur, Voorthuizen, Garderen to Het Loo Palace in Apeldoorn. Something we still benefit from today. The route starts at Gasterij Zondag in Garderen, also at the time an ideal location for a stopover with the carriage. Princes are also known to have made a stopover at other locations. One reminder of this is a bust of Louis Napoléon at hotel-restaurant de Echoput.

Tip: *the dotted line on the map shows via 21 the old main road from Voorthuizen towards Gasterij Zondag. On this road is the former Roskam, also a household name in those days!*



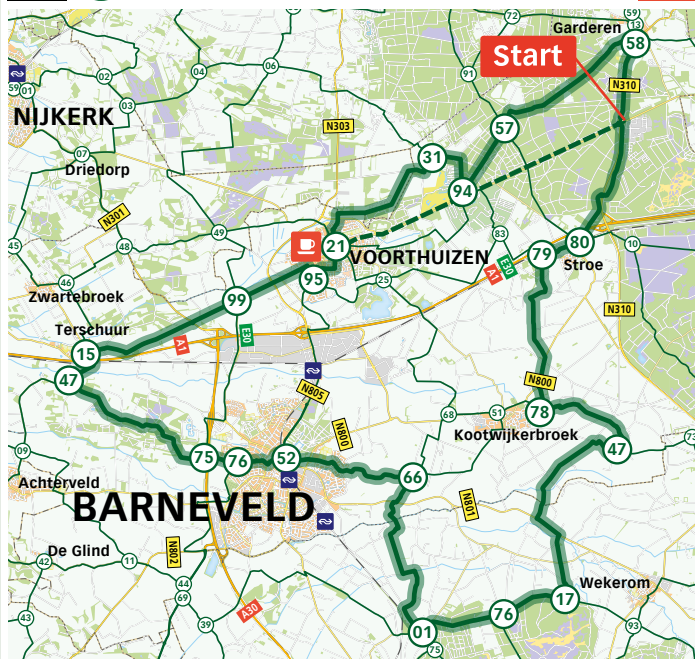
